

## FULLY VACCINATED RESIDENTS:

- Do not need to quarantine upon admission, readmission or return to the facility.
  - Exception: IF they develop symptoms.
- May have close contact with visitors including physical touch.
- May have close contact with OTHER vaccinated individuals.
- SHOULD wear a mask in the following situations:
  - When visiting with unvaccinated people.
  - When walking around INSIDE the building.
  - If participating in a group activity involving singing.
  - When going on an outing if unvaccinated people are involved.

## NON-VACCINATED RESIDENTS:

- Must quarantine upon admission or readmission to the facility.
  - May be required to quarantine upon return from an outing based on a risk assessment.
- Must wear source control
  - Whenever outside of his/her room.
  - Whenever a visitor is with them.
  - Whenever on an outing outside of Fairview Haven.
- Must continue to social distance from all other residents, visitors and team members (as appropriate)

## VISITORS:

- Call ahead to schedule visits.
- Visitors will not be allowed if:
  - Positive
  - Symptomatic
  - Or close contact in past 14 days
- OUTDOOR VISITS ALWAYS PREFERRED.
- Wear source control at all times in the building and/or around residents.
  - IF Resident and ALL visitors are FULLY vaccinated, masks may be removed DURING the visit only.
    - Those visitors who are fully vaccinated will have a gold star on their name badge.
- Social distance from residents, team and other visitors not in your group.
  - Vaccinated residents may have close contact with their visitor.
- Use proper Hand Hygiene.
- Only allowed in resident rooms or in designated visiting areas.
- If you develop symptoms within three days, need to report to the Administrator.

**VISITS WILL BE SUSPENDED IF FAIRVIEW HAVEN HAS AN OUTBREAK.**

## FULLY VACCINATED TEAM MEMBERS:

- Must continue to wear source control inside the building and/or whenever in the presence of a resident.
  - Exception – If team members are on breaks, or in NON-resident areas with ONLY other vaccinated team members, they may remove their source control.
- Are only required to test if they have symptoms or if Fairview Haven has an outbreak status.

Communal Dining is back to normal. Church services and other group activities will return to normal (without additional visitors) in the Family Room/Chapel.

## Bridge Phase/Phase 5

Fairview Haven strongly encourages residents to follow the guidance put forth by CDC and IDPH concerning what activities they should participate in on social outings away from the campus. Under phase 4, for example, we strongly discouraged residents from attending church services where attendance exceeded 50 people.

With the Bridge phase, residents could now attend gatherings of 250 people indoors (assuming appropriate spacing and adequate ventilation) or 500 people outdoors. This would allow most of our residents the opportunity to attend church services.

We are asking that residents please wear masks when attending gatherings involving unvaccinated persons and social distancing where possible.

Bridge Phase is possibly set to take effect on Friday, May 14 and phase 5 could be as early as June 11. Keep up the diligence!
