



February 1, 2021

Resident/Family Members

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Fairview Haven is in PHASE 1 of the reopening guidance from IDPH.

- Residents are out of their rooms.
- Those needing assistance are allowed to eat in the dining room.
- Small group activities (ie: church, Bingo)
- Residents can move freely between buildings (exception, only immediate family members from Serenity are allowed to visit Fairview)

February 8, 2021

Fairview Haven will enter Phase 2

- Beauty Shop will open for all residents (February 1, we opened for Post-COVID residents).
- Group activities – Residents must wear masks and sit 6 feet apart.

February 16, 2021

Residents and team members who received vaccine will have full immunity from the vaccine.

- Communal Dining – All residents will come to dining room, but seated 6 feet apart.
- Indoor visits will be permitted so long as Livingston County positivity rate remains below 10%.
 - Visiting parlors or outdoor visits ALWAYS preferred.
 - Residents who are under Isolation or quarantine cannot receive visitors.
 - Visit must be scheduled in advance and visitors must be screened upon arriving at the front desk.
 - ONLY 2 visitors from the same household allowed at a time.
 - Visitors are ONLY allowed in the resident room or other designated area, MUST maintain 6 feet social distance, avoid physical contact, wear face covering, and practice great hand hygiene.
- Volunteers will be able to be utilized (minimal who provide essential services) a “program” will be coordinated by Trish Steidinger.

February 22, 2021

LORD WILLING (we must meet all the guidelines set forth by Illinois Department of Public Health to proceed) Fairview Haven will move to Phase 3

- Group activities – may be led by a volunteer (max 2 volunteers from same household)
- Outings (**allowed for residents who have full immunity from vaccination or 90 days post-COVID starting February 16, 2021**)
 - Continue to use caution, MASK, social distance, avoid meals (or properly distance while eating)
 - Follow IDPH COVID-19 guidance (ie: no gatherings to exceed 50)
 - Ensure proper hand hygiene.
 - AVOID Physical contact.
 - If out overnight, resident must quarantine 14 days upon return.

Testing:

- Symptomatic Testing:
 - Any resident or team member who displays COVID-19 like symptoms will be tested with a Rapid Antigen test.
- Repeat Testing:
 - If a positive facility associated or acquired case is identified, we will begin testing twice weekly with rapid antigen tests until 14 days have passed with no new positives.
 - Residents have the right to refuse testing and we will assume vaccinated residents wish to refuse unless otherwise noted.
- Routine Testing:
 - Routine testing will be done on team members only. The tests will be performed monthly for the time being but can be adjusted based on the county positivity rate.

Independent Living:

- Once things open up a bit, if Independent Living “community dweller” wish to convert to “Fairview Haven dweller”, you may do so IF you are willing to abide by all the above guidelines (ie: gatherings less than 50, masking, social distancing, etc)
